

What are tiles/panels made of?

Self-adhesive wall and floor tiles or panels are made of high-quality vinyl material with a thickness of 1.1 mm, reinforced with a PES mesh and adhesive. The self-adhesive layer is covered with a protective film. These products are highly resistant to stretching, tearing, and bending. The synthetic fiber material prevents the accumulation of microorganisms and bacteria, making it hygienic and durable.

Before starting the installation

Before applying vinyl products to the wall or floor, properly prepare the surface. Remove any unevenness and thoroughly clean it (e.g., from glue residues) and degrease. Installation should be done on a clean and dry surface. Fill all uneven spots and gaps larger than 0.5 mm; otherwise, they may show through the structure of the applied material. **Tips: 1.** When installing on ceramic tiles, make sure grout lines are no wider than 2 mm. For wider grout lines, fill and level them. **2.** If installing behind a gas stove, maintain at least a 20 cm distance from the burner. **3.** The room temperature during installation should be at least +10°C.

Application of self-adhesive vinyl tiles or panels:

1. Lay out the vinyl tiles or panels in a safe place and check the pattern alignment. Ensure the product matches your order and has no defects. If there are any damages, contact us immediately by email or phone. **2.** Before installation, remove the protective film from the back of the product. Align the tile or panel with the surface and press it firmly, paying special attention to the edges. Install subsequent pieces without leaving gaps, carefully matching the pattern. If necessary, use a utility knife to trim the material. **3. Note!** The adhesive reaches maximum strength after 24 hours. Do not use the installed products during this time (do not walk on them, clean them, etc.).

How to clean tiles and panels? To clean vinyl tiles or panels, use a damp cloth and mild detergents to keep them looking great for a long time!

IMPORTANT! Follow precautions when using this product.

The product is made of vinyl – handle with care to prevent damage during installation and use. Do not place the product in areas exposed to direct fire contact. Keep away from children – risk of choking on small parts or protective film. In case of material damage (e.g., tears, cracks), immediately stop use and dispose of the product safely. Failure to follow these recommendations may result in product damage or personal injury.
